All of today's activities have been organized with specially modified protocols, adhering to CDC guidelines.

Thank you for your cooperation and your flexibility as you Swing for Kids.

Rules of a Shamble

- 1. Like a scramble, all players within a foursome tee-off from the designated tees on that hole, and the best drive among the group is selected.
- 2. From the selected tee shot, each player will play their own ball until they hole out. (Note: the scramble element is only used on the tee shot; no more choosing the best shot within the group after the tee shot!)
- 3. Each foursome team will finish each hole with four scores (one score per player). We are using the 2 best scores (combined) for every hole. Please circle the two players' scores you are using on each hole. Note: the two players' combined score you select from your group must be used for both Gross and Net (handicap flight). Post the two combined players' score under the Team Gross and the same two combined players' score, adjusted for their handicaps, under Team Net. (Again, you must use the same two players' scores for both Gross and Net.)
- 4. You must use 3 holes from each team member for your team scoring; in other words, your worst player's score has to be used 3 times within the Team Gross & Team Net tally.

Important Information

Here are some of the protocols we have implemented for our golf tournament, to ensure your day of play is safe and worry-free:

- · We will have assigned tee times (every 10 minutes), off #1 and #10 (beginning at 10:00am)
- · No formal "registration" (no lines, no waiting) everyone will be asked to register (and provide their credit card) ahead of arrival
- \cdot Please arrive NO MORE than 1½ hours before your tee time, and NO LESS than 30 minutes before your tee time
- · You are asked to be at your assigned hole 10 MINUTES before your tee time please do not be late!
- · Part of the registration process is the completion of a COVID questionnaire
- · Temperatures will be taken upon arrival
- · Golfers must put their own bag on their own cart (carts will be ready and named/labeled for you for your tee time)
- · Breakfast goodies (all served by the Club, wrapped), Bloody Mary Bar and Haus of Grey Tee Gifts before you tee off
- · Putting contest before you tee off (just you and your foursome on the putting green)
- · 2 bags per cart
- · One driver at a time
- · One golfer walks; one drives
- · We will have a "sanitation station" every 3 holes: volunteers will be there to wipe cart down, so that driver/walker can change places. (So, everyone will get a bit more exercise!)
- · All golfers will be given their own hand sanitizer to carry with them
- · Masks (and gloves, as appropriate) will be worn by all volunteers at all times
- · Masks are asked of golfers when in any common area (OIC will supply extra masks)
- All food is being prepared and served according to county standards (a culinary extravaganza will be throughout the course!)
- · No banquet
- · Instead, we are having a 19th Hole stop at the clubhouse for a gourmet coffee and desserts (to go if you like), play Chuck-A-Luck, view silent auction, have one last "cheers" before you go on your way
- Our tournament partner, GiveSmart, will be sending you text messages and emails to keep you up to date on everything
